

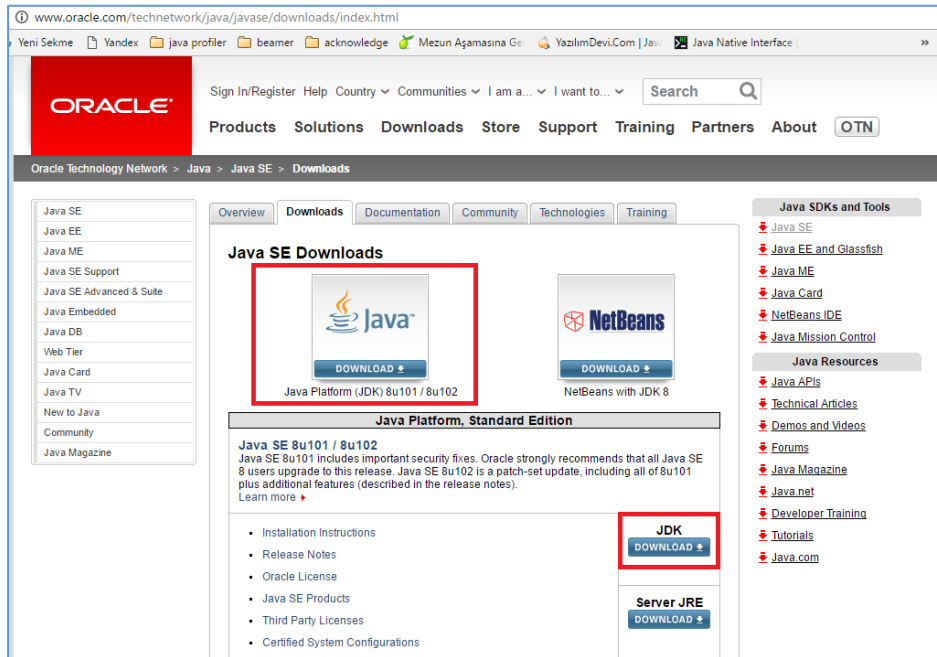

## JAVA JDK INSTALLATION GUIDE

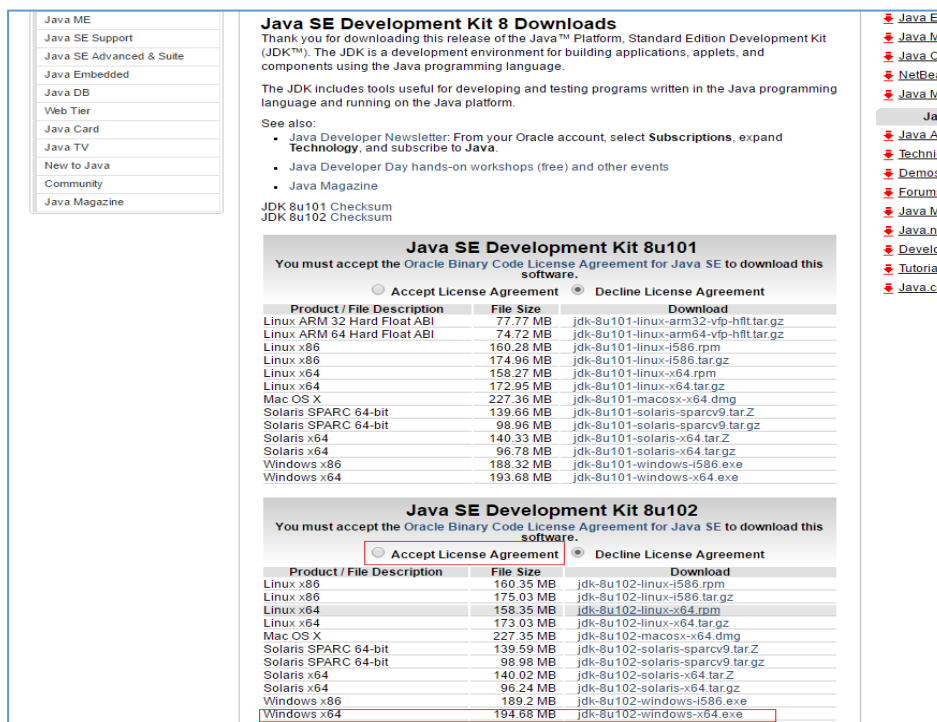
### HOW TO INSTALL JDK

#### 1. Download Java JDK

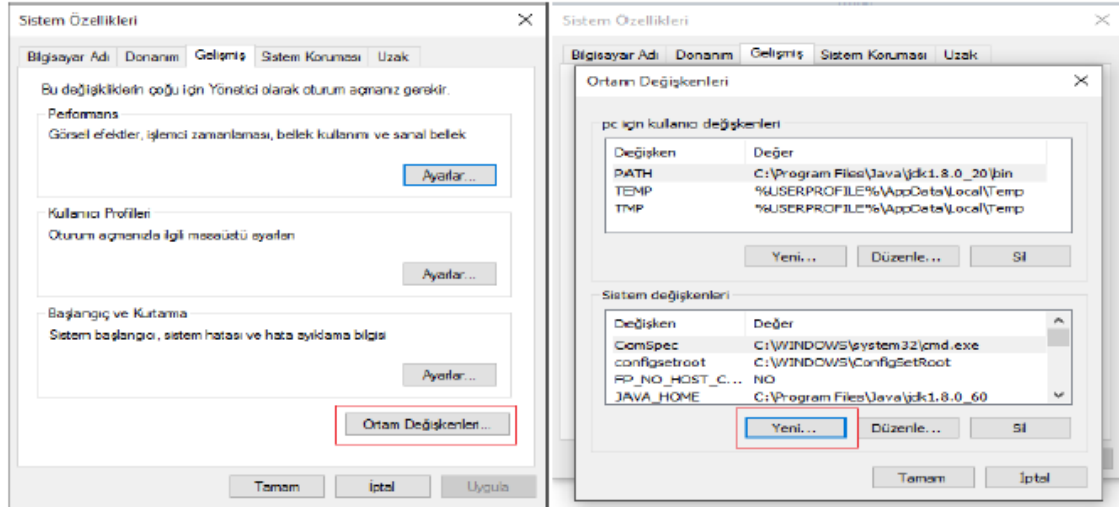
- a. Visit <http://www.oracle.com/technetwork/java/javase/downloads/index.html> and download JDK



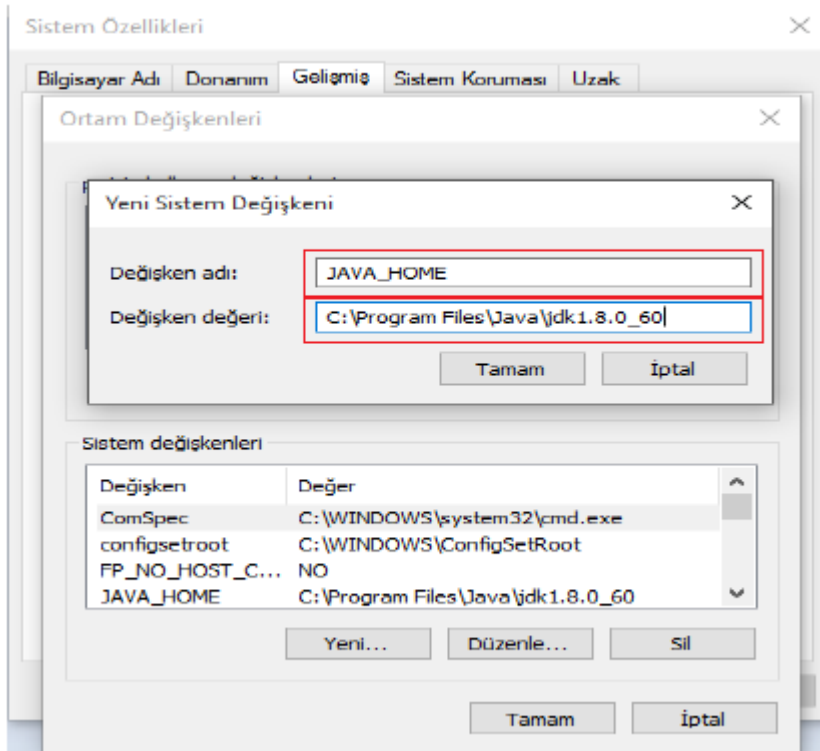
2. You should accept License Agreement and choose your Operating System (OS) to start download.



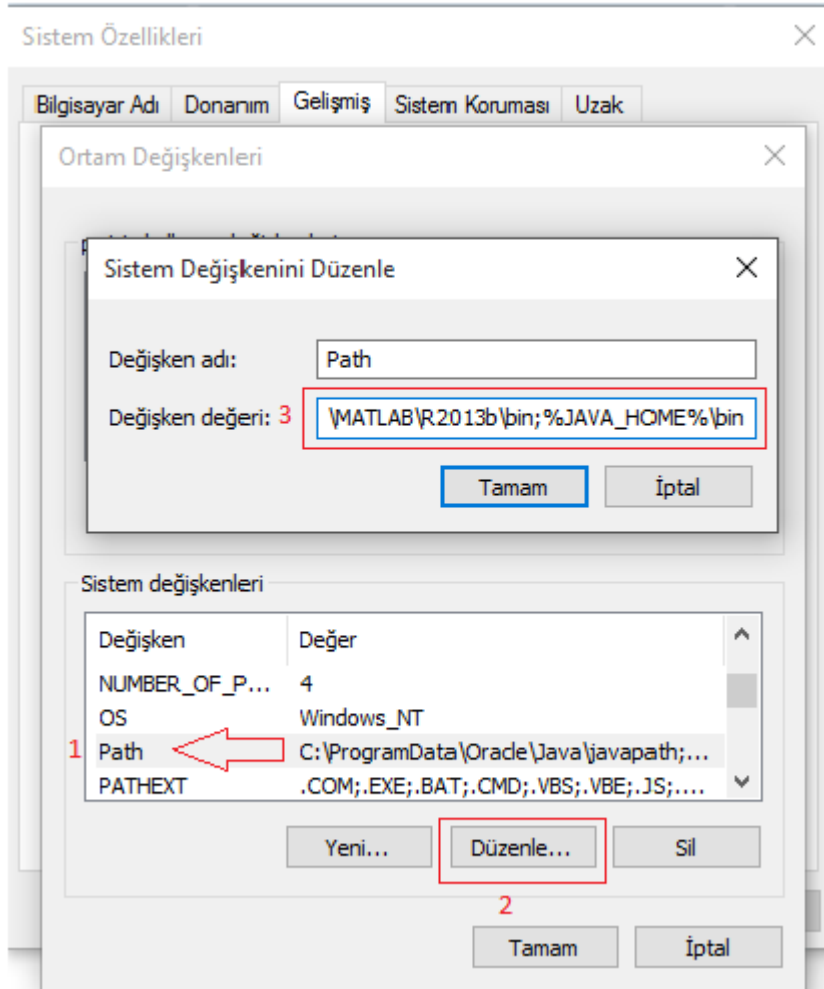
3. Install the setup file. There is no special setting; just click next statements.
4. After installation you should follow these steps:  
Computer > Properties > Advanced System Settings > Environmental Variables > New



5. Enter JAVA\_HOME keyword and file directory of Java JDK.



6. Follow these steps which are shown in figure. You have to add end of the line  
;%JAVA\_HOME%\bin



7. Last step is checking the installation open command prompt (komut istemi) and enter " java -version " keyword if you do not get any error your installation is successfully done otherwise check your steps again.
