



## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)

The purpose of the TOEFL® test is to evaluate the English proficiency of people whose native language is not English.

The test is given in two formats, depending on where the test is taken. The paper-based test is given on up to 12 scheduled dates (see calendar) in Algeria, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cambodia, Hong Kong, India, Japan, Korea, Laos, Macau, Myanmar, Pakistan, People's Republic of China, Taiwan, Thailand, and Vietnam. Elsewhere, the test is given in a computer-based format by appointment (see the *Information Bulletin for Computer-Based Testing*). Both forms of the test evaluate a student's ability to listen and understand English as it is spoken in North America, to recognize and write standard written English, and to read and understand nontechnical reading matter. If the test center list on pages 15-19 indicates that supplemental paper-based testing will take place, candidates must refer to the test center list for supplemental administrations on pages 20-22 and obtain an *Information Bulletin for Supplemental TOEFL Administrations* by writing to TOEFL Services, Educational Testing Service, PO Box 6151, Princeton, NJ, 08541-6151, USA, or calling 1-609-771-7100. ### Test of Written English (TWE)

The purpose of the TWE® test is to provide students with an opportunity to demonstrate their ability to write in English in response to an assigned topic. This includes the ability to organize ideas, to support those ideas with examples and evidence, and to compose in standard written English. The TWE test score does not affect the total TOEFL score; it is used as an additional measure by some colleges and universities to evaluate students' writing proficiency.

In 1999-2000, this 30-minute essay test will be offered with the *paper-based* TOEFL test at the August, October, December, February, and May administrations. In addition, if you take a supplemental administration, you will be required to take the TWE test.

### Test of Spoken English (TSE)

The purpose of the TSE® test is to evaluate the spoken English proficiency of people whose native language is not English. It requires examinees to answer orally a variety of questions presented in printed and recorded form. Spoken answers are recorded on tape.

The TSE test is paper-based and administered 12 times a year (see the calendar on this page and the test center list beginning on page 5). A separate TSE test center list for candidates taking the computer-based TOEFL test begins on page 23.

The cost of the TSE is **US\$125**. The TSE program has two registration categories: TSE-A and TSE-P.

**TSE-A** is for teaching and research assistant applicants who have been requested to take the TSE test by the admissions office or department chair of an academic institution. TSE-A is also for undergraduate or graduate school applicants.

**TSE-P** is for all other individuals, such as those who are taking the TSE test to obtain licensure or certification in a professional or occupational field.

### Test Registration/Information Bulletins

To register for the paper-based TOEFL, TWE, and TSE tests, students must complete a registration form contained in the 1999-2000 *Information Bulletin for TOEFL, TWE, and TSE*. In countries and areas where the computer-based TOEFL test is given, candidates

must schedule an appointment to test after reading the 1999-2000 *Information Bulletin for Computer-Based Testing*. Students planning to take a supplemental administration must use the registration form in the *Information Bulletin for Supplemental TOEFL Administrations*.

A separate information bulletin for the Test of Spoken English is available for candidates who are taking the computer-based TOEFL test.

Institutions may order a supply of bulletins free of charge from the office that serves its country or area (see back cover). Bulletins may also be downloaded or ordered by institutions and candidates from the TOEFL Web site at [www.toefl.org](http://www.toefl.org) and are available at the office serving their area (a list is on the TOEFL Web site), United States educational commissions and foundations, United States Information Service offices, and binational centers and private educational organizations, such as the Institute of International Education. ## Fee Voucher Service

The TOEFL program offers a fee voucher service for the convenience of institutions and agencies that choose to pay the TOEFL and/or TSE test fees for their students or applicants.

There are no fees for this service; fee vouchers are provided to participating organizations without charge. Institutions and agencies are billed only for the number

of vouchers processed. A minimum of 10 vouchers must be used per academic year.

Upon receipt of a completed fee voucher request form or letter (on agency letterhead), vouchers are prepared in the quantity ordered and sent to the address provided. The completed form or letter serves as authorization for ETS to send fee vouchers to the designated individuals and to bill the institution or agency for the vouchers used. Each fee voucher is overprinted with the name and code number of the participating institution or agency and is valid only for the test year and the program (TOEFL or TSE) specified thereon.

The fee voucher service can be particularly useful to institutions and agencies working with students in Eastern Bloc countries or in such areas as mainland China where it is difficult for students to obtain US dollars. Fee vouchers are distributed by participating institutions and agencies directly to all examinees for whom they will pay the registration fees. The test takers, in turn, use the completed vouchers in lieu of their own personal payment.

Following each test administration, a sponsoring institution receives the scores for each examinee who submitted a fee voucher and an itemized invoice listing the number of vouchers used. The invoice also includes the locations of the test centers at which the examinees tested.

It is important to note that the locations of test centers are relevant to TOEFL/TSE test fees. Because of fluctuations in the value of the US dollar compared to other world currencies, differential fee schedules are necessary in certain countries. Because of high operating costs within the countries most affected, TOEFL/TSE test fees have been adjusted accordingly.

## IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR INSTITUTION AND AGENCY OFFICIALS

The TOEFL program reports scores for a period of two years after a test administration. The official score report routinely sent to institutions and other TOEFL score recipients designated by the test taker, as well as the examinee's own copy of the score report, bear an electronically reproduced photo image of the examinee.

If there is any doubt about the identity of an examinee who took the TOEFL test, or if there is reason to suspect possible impersonation or misconduct, we urge institutions to contact ETS. Please send a brief explanation with either the official score report or the examinee's score record to:
